



PATAGONIA: CHILE & ARGENTINA November 2019 2 Travelers

DAY 1 | ARRIVE SANTIAGO

- Upon arrival, you will meet your driver and be transferred to your hotel
- Spend the evening at leisure

ACCOMMODATION: The Singular Santiago (Patio Room)

DAY 2 | SANTIAGO TO TORRES DEL PAINE (B, L, D)

- Private transfer to the airport this morning
- Fly Santiago to Puerto Natales
- Upon arrival into Puerto Natales you'll be met and transferred to your hotel for a four-night, allinclusive stay
- Towering above the immense Patagonian steppe, the spectacular granite pillars of Torres del Paine dominate the landscape. Flanked by the summit of Paine Grande and the black sedimentary peaks of Los Cuernos, these are the famous Patagonian mountains that you see on posters everywhere. Torres del Paine National Park covers 181,000 hectares.
- There are many hiking paths that cross widely differing types of terrain, such as steppes and thick Magellanic forests, and run along lakes with huge glaciers and icebergs. Its highly developed infrastructure makes it possible to do the whole 'W' hike while sleeping in beds, eating hot meals, taking showers, and even drinking cocktails!

DAYS 3-5 | TORRES DEL PAINE (B, L, D)

Emerging beside craggy mountains and the glistening Lake Sarmiento in Torres del Paine National Park, Tierra Patagonia weaves itself into the landscape with subtle style, blending into the magnificence of the region. Here in this untamed part of the world, what you see at this adventure spa hotel is emerald lakes, fantastic mountain ranges, and abundant wildlife.

DAY 6 | TORRES DEL PAINE TO CALAFATE (B, L, D)

- Travel overland (in a private vehicle) from Torres del Paine to Calafate, crossing the border from Chile into Argentina as you go (approx. 5-7 hours)
- Your next three nights will be spent in rustic luxury at a working estancia/farm that offers worldclass service in a stunning setting!

DAY 7 | EL CALAFATE (B, L, D)

- In the middle of the steppe and constantly buffeted by the southern wind, El Calafate is one of the country's most visited destinations for the outlying spectacular attractions: The Perito Moreno Glacier and National Park Los Glaciares.
- Around Lago Argentino, a lake with a surface area of 1600 square kilometers and so deep its temperature remains 8º C year round, straight down from the South Continental Ice Cup, an

array of glaciers can be visited and travelers from all the world are bewitched by the magic of a zillion shades of blue and white and by the thundering noise of ice cracking into the lakes...

Today will be yours to enjoy the many daily activities offered by the hotel

DAY 8 | GLACIERS (B, L, D)

- Pioneros Tour Patagonia has secrets to tell through its first settlers. In a tour
 accessible to everyone, we invite you to get to know the culture of Argentina
 surrounded by breathtaking landscapes.
- From Nibepo, sail along the Lago Argentino and enjoy a gentle walk in the beech forest. We will come to a natural viewpoint with stunning views of the Perito Moreno Glacier!
- Later, the crew will give a toast with **whiskey and glacier ice**. Walk on the catwalks of the National Park to admire the different faces of the ice, and then return to the estancia.

DAY 10 | USHUAIA (B)

- Half Day Trekking at Lapataia Bay (Private tour)
 - O Walk along easy and undemanding paths. This track (3 hours, 7 km long) is one of the most beautiful in the Park with lots of vegetation (High Deciduous Beech, Low Deciduous Beech, Evergreen Beech, Wintersbark, Firebush, etc.).
 - o Continue to Lapataia Bay and along this trip you will see spectacular seabirds of the Argentinean South (Albatrosses, Petrels, Snowy Sheath Bills and sometimes Penguins).
 - Arrive to Lapataia Bay, to the end of the Panamerican Highway, and the end of the world. Here, you'll meet your van to go back to town.

Beagle Channel Navigation Regular Service (Shared Tour)

- Leaving the local harbour, navigate along the Beagle Channel and admire the sight of the mountain range that surrounds the city.
- The Isla de los Lobos and Isla de los Pájaros, on the Bridges Archipelago, are good spots for watching sea lions, cormorants, albatrosses, skuas, petrels, and seagulls.
- o Another interesting part of the trip is the famous lighthouse

 Les Eclaireurs and the Estancia Túnel, an historic site on the northern shore. *Note:*



Private transfer back to the hotel this evening
